## HOUSING/CASE MANAGEMENT

SSG/HOPICS assists with emergency housing resources placement into interim, systems navigation support, case management, and referrals to behavioral health and trauma focused services. [www.hopics.org](http://www.hopics.org)

**Program Qualifications:** Homeless or at risk of homelessness.



## SUBSTANCE ABUSE/TREATMENT LINKAGE

Cens/Hopics CENS ensures connection to Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment services for everyone in Los Angeles County. [www.hopics.org](http://www.hopics.org)

**Program Qualifications:** Referral submitted by a Case Manager, Probation Officer, or come to the main HOPICS office on Broadway seeking SUD assessment and referrals and assistance with accessing treatment services.



## EMPLOYMENT

The Chrysalis Center works with individuals to identify, prepare for, and maintain employment, including opportunities for paid transitional employment. [www.changelives.org](http://www.changelives.org)

**Program Qualifications:** 18 years and older and motivated to work. (Our program is open to individuals who are ready, willing, and able to begin their job search.)



## FAMILY REUNIFICATION SERVICES

A New Way of Life provides family preservation/reunification services including case management, DCFS system navigation support, legal support for child custody and visitation issues, visitation monitoring, and education/advocacy. <https://anewwayoflife.org/>

**Program Qualifications:** Formerly incarcerated parents wanting to reunify with minor children with cases is based in Los Angeles County.



## LEGAL SUPPORT

Legal Aid Foundation of LA provides legal assistance in the following areas: expungement; post-conviction/criminal record, housing, immigration, family law, and consumer law. [www.lafla.org](http://www.lafla.org)

**Program Qualifications:** LAFLA follows federal poverty guidelines and assists only people with income less than 125% of the federal poverty guidelines. However, sometimes people with income over 125% of the federal poverty guidelines can qualify as well.

## EDUCATION/SELF HELP GROUPS

Five Keys Schools and Programs provides test preparation and financial assistance with testing fees for students in pursuit of their GED or High School diploma. **Program Qualifications:** Justice impacted, court mandated or DCFS mandated.



## INVEST/WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT, AGING AND COMMUNITY SERVICES (WDACS)

**Program Qualifications:** The INVEST program is open to all adults on Formal Probation and AB 109 supervision. The only individuals who are not eligible for INVEST are those with convictions related to sex offenses or arson.



## DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH

DMH offers mental health screening, support groups, and linkage to services. <https://dmh.lacounty.gov/>

**Program Qualifications:** Participants must have active medical coverage to qualify for services. If a participant does not have medical insurance, they may still receive services, but fees will be assessed on a sliding scale based on their ability to pay.
